FIFTEEN HUNDRED GO DOWN TO DEATH IN THE SEA

STEAMSHIP TITANIC COLLIDES WITH BERG

Greatest Ship in World Founders at Sea Carrying With Her to the Bottom Fifteen-Hundred and Twenty-Five Souls

The White Star Line admits probably only 675 passengers out of the 2,200 on board the Titanic have been saved

Untold Wealth in 'One More Hope' Passenger List Now Shattered

ESTIMATES ARE INCREASED

GREATEST MARINE DISASTER IN HISTORY OF OLD OCEAN

While Officials of White Star Line Still Hope for Best, They Admit That There Has Been Horrible Loss of Life Early Hours Destroyed

AWFUL PLUNGE TO DEATH

ESTIMATES ARE INCREASED

NEW YORK, April 15.—The report from the officers of the Titanic, which was received here today, has caused a sharp increase in the estimates of the number of lives lost in the disaster. It is now believed that the total number of deaths will reach 2,200, including the crew and passengers.

Franklin Has Lost Hope

NEW YORK, April 15.—The White Star Line officials here today admitted that they had lost all hope of recovering the bodies of the Titanic victims. They said that the search for the ship had been abandoned because of the extreme cold and the danger to the searchers.

Franklin Refuses for Assistance

NEW YORK, April 15.—The White Star Line officials here today refused to accept any assistance from the British government in the search for the Titanic. They said that the ship was insured and that the British government was not responsible for the disaster.
