

TWO DIVORCES FILED IN DISTRICT COURT

Mabel Harris Alleges Course of Violent Treatment and Esther Steele Alleges Desertion.

Two suits for divorce were filed in the district court yesterday afternoon, the allegations being cruel treatment in one case and desertion and non-support in the other.

Mabel Harris in her complaint, filed by Attorneys Grimstad and Brown, alleges that she was married to Robert Sidney Harris at St. Paul, Minn., in October, 1909, and within a few months after their marriage the defendant commenced a course of violent treatment toward the plaintiff which caused her suffering and mental anguish to the extent that she was forced to leave him and earn her own living.

The complaint asks that the woman's maiden name, Mabel Smith, be restored by a decree of the court, besides an absolute divorce from the defendant.

In a complaint filed by Attorney T. L. Tilton, Esther Steele sets forth that after living with William Steele for about 18 years he deserted her in 1910 without good cause and has continued to remain away and that he has failed to support her for more than the past year.
