

### MICHIGAN ALUMNI TO SMOKE TONIGHT

**MOCK TRIAL, MICHIGAN VS. HARVARD, TO FEATURE THE GATHERING.**

A feature smoker will be given this evening by the alumni of the University of Michigan in the racketeerie of the Elks' club building. The affair is to be in celebration of the Michigan-Harvard football game played at Harvard's field this afternoon. It is the first time the two teams have met in 20 years.

The smoker, which will start at 8 o'clock, will take the form of a mock trial. The University of Michigan, personified by Dr. W. R. Morrison, has preferred charges of assault and battery against Harvard college to be personified by Attorney O. K. Grimstad. Attorney Louis Chapple will preside as judge.

The attorney for the plaintiff, G. E. Shell, has prepared a vigorous attack upon the college, whose defense will be maintained by Rockwood Brown. Counsel for the plaintiff has already summoned two important witnesses, Coach Yost, in the person of Warren Dedrick, promise to make some startling disclosures, and Dr. Balsam as a medical expert will give some equally important testimony with regard to the assault upon Michigan.

To substantiate its claim that the charges are false and without foundation in fact the defense will call on Coach Percy Haughton, who will be represented by Harry Chapple, and Dr. Watkins, a medical expert who, the defense claims, can give some light on the case which will positively prove the falsity of the charges against Harvard college.

A jury picked from the remaining alumni will hear the case. Judge Cline will act as referee, and it is whispered has already agreed to use his influence in favor of a verdict against Harvard.

Aids from the mock trial the committee in charge of the affair, consisting of Warren Dedrick, Harry Chapple and Rockwood Brown, announce that a special report of the game will be received during the evening, furnished by the United Press. There will be an abundance of "Michigan" refreshments, and the affair promises to be the most successful of its kind ever attempted in Billings.

The alumni of the surrounding towns have been extended a hearty invitation to attend the smoker this evening, and the committee expects fully 50 Michigan graduates to be present.
