

BIG LAND DEAL IS CONSUMMATED

7,600 ACRES OF LAND IN
CUSTER COUNTY SOLD
TO LIBBY MAN

Announcement of one of the most important realty deals that has been consummated this year in eastern Montana was made yesterday by E. M. Adams, sales manager for the Midland Securities company in the Acme building, it being the sale of 7,600 acres of land near the Custer forest reserve in Custer county by S. W. Kelsey to John H. Town, a well known livestock man of Libby. The consideration was not made public but it is understood to have been between \$130,000 and \$140,000.

The ranch is located some 60 miles south of Miles City and considerable of it is cultivated. Some of the finest alfalfa seed in the state is grown there. Mr. Town will materially improve and stock the property.

Including this deal the company has recently consummated real estate transactions in farm lands amounting to over \$175,000. The other land sold is mostly situated near Rapids, where the company has some extensive holdings.

The Midland Securities company is a local concern of which F. E. Williams, S. D. MacDonald, James Selley and Rockwood Brown are among the local stockholders.
