

## EASTERN CONCERN MAKES BIG DEAL IN MONTANA LAND

An aggregate of 20,000 acres of eastern Montana land, lying near Toluca, was sold yesterday by Dow & Starks of Madison, Wis., to two local syndicates for a total of \$236,000, according to announcements made yes-

terday.

The Madison firm last week sold a tract of 8,000 acres to a syndicate represented by Rockwood Brown, O. K. Grimstad, C. W. Rowen and Theodore Dugar. Yesterday the syndicate resold the property to James Shoemaker of the Automobile Warehouse & Service company, and associates, who are preparing to plow it and plant a large part of the land in winter wheat.

Yesterday the firm sold a tract of 12,000 acres to the syndicate compr-

ing Messrs. Brown, Grimstad, Bowen and Dugar, making the two sales in the aggregate one of the largest deals in realty ever made in eastern Montana land.

All of the deals were made through the Matheson-Vredenburg agency, which handled the local end of the transactions.
