

O. KING GRIMSTAD LEAVES TONIGHT TO ENTER NAVAL AERO TRAINING STATION

O. King Grimstad, member of the law firm of Grimstad and Brown, exalted ruler of the local Elks lodge and prominent in business and social circles in Billings, leaves on No. 4 this evening for Great Lakes, Ill., to report for duty at the naval aviation training station. Mr. Grimstad enlisted in the naval aero branch while in Washington, D. C., several weeks ago, and yesterday received orders to report for duty.

Mr. Grimstad has two brothers in active service in France. Both enlisted in Minnesota. Knute Grimstad recently received a shrapnel wound while engaged in the front line trenches and now is in a military hospital in France. He is reported recovering rapidly and expects soon to join his regiment. Another brother, Clayton Grimstad, has been in the front line trenches for some time.

In addition to offering himself to the service of his country, Mr. Grimstad, in conjunction with his partner, Rockwood Brown, produced \$40,000 worth of crops on a ranch near Billings owned in partnership. Mr. Grimstad is married and has a wife and child in Billings, where they plan to remain temporarily.

A six months' course in naval aviation, including piloting of hydroplanes, is offered at the Great Lakes station. Mr. Grimstad hopes to see active service shortly after completing this course.
