

DAILY FLU REPORTS TO BE DISCONTINUED

HELENA, Nov. 7.—Daily reports on the influenza situation from county to state board of health are to be discontinued under orders of the federal health department. Doctors, however, are required to report daily to county boards and the latter weekly to state boards. Little change in the situation in Montana was received today. Livingston had 44 new cases, Glendive 11, Miles City 15, Billings 31 and 3 deaths, Butte 2 and 11 deaths, Missoula 14 and 1 death, Havre 14, Red Lodge 10 and 4 deaths.

This county reports 41 cases and 4 deaths.
