

**EDGAR GUTHARD
COMPANY IS
FORMED**

**Will Deal in Patented
Products; Articles
Are Filed**

Articles of incorporation were filed with the county clerk and recorder here on Saturday by the Edgar C. Guthard and company, which is capitalized at \$200,000. The incorporators and directors, three in number, all Billings men, are Edgar C. and Charles H. Guthard and Rockwood Brown.

The objects for which the incorporation was formed is to apply for buy and sell or otherwise dispose of letters patent or licenses of the United States or any foreign country and to use and manufacture or grant licenses owned or controlled by the company and to test the validity of the patent rights.

The incorporation proposes to purchase, lease or acquire lands and buildings for the erection and establishment of work shops with suitable plants, engines and machinery with the view of manufacturing, buying, selling, importing or exporting and dealing in either direct or indirectly in the products through the medium of agents.

One of the purposes of the incorporation also is to act as manufacturers and others agents in the buying and selling of all kinds of articles, both manufactured, unmanufactured and in the process of manufacture. Also, to manufacture, buy, sell, import and export and deal in machinery, tools, appliances, factory supplies and hardware of all kinds.

To accomplish this end the incorporation is empowered to hold and convey real estate and issue stock.

The principal place of business of the company is at Billings. The term of incorporation is 40 years.

Business of the company is to be conducted by a board of three directors elected from among the stockholders with their powers clearly defined in the incorporation articles.

The amount of capital stock is divided into 4,000 shares of a par value of \$50 each, nonassessable.

The company will have the right to conduct its business in this state or in any part of the world.
