

**50 BILLINGS BOYS LEAVE
THIS MORNING FOR CAMP
LOCATED NEAR RED LODGE**

Have Complete Program for Two Weeks of Outdoor Sport.

More than 50 boys from Billings will leave for Camp Allen near Red Lodge this morning where for 12 days they will camp out under the auspices of the Y. M. C. A. Most of the boys will go by auto. cars for the trip being furnished by H. A. Caroway, H. S. Barringer, W. McLaughlin, Charles Ridley, Percy Goan, Rockwood Brown, J. H. McElroy, A. Bolander, L. H. Drake, George Selvidge, C. C. Cohagen, Robert Shipley and perhaps others. The rest will go by train under the leadership of Kirk Badgely.

Mr. Badgely and the Rev. Huber Burr returned Saturday night from the camp where they had spent a number of days getting the camp in readiness and announced that everything was set for the outing. Besides their regular outfit, most of the boys are planning on taking along their swimming suits and plenty of fishing tackle.

According to the plans for the camp, there will be daily hikes by the different groups of boys. There will be one overnight hike when the boys will tramp to Lost Lake and spend two days and a night there. On the other hikes all points of interest in the locality will be sought.

The boys are divided into groups of seven each with a leader in charge. A complete program for each day has been worked out consisting of first aid, nature and Bible study classes, athletics and games.
