

### NAME RENWICK PRESIDENT OF MIDLAND FAIR

#### Board Reorganizes; More Room in Grand Stands.

W. C. Renwick was elected president of the board of fair commissioners of the Midland Empire fair at an organization meeting for the 1923 exhibit, held at the courthouse Tuesday afternoon.

Mr. Renwick was a member of the board of county commissioners at the time of the inception of the Midland Empire fair and has always been active in promoting its success. He has served for two years on the fair board, having been treasurer last year. The other officers elected for the year are E. N. Cooper, vice president, W. A. Selvidge, secretary, and H. L. Felco, treasurer.


O. J. Thomas, the retiring president, remains a member of the board. Mr. Thomas has served for eight years on the board and is the only member of the original board serving. A vote of thanks was given him by the other members of the board as follows:

"We, the members of the board of fair commissioners, having served for the last year and a half with Mr. Thomas as president, take this opportunity to thank him for the fine service rendered. He has been most loyal to duty and has constantly endeavored to further the interests of the Midland Empire fair in every way and everywhere.

A number of important decisions concerning the fair this year were made at the meeting with the view of making it in even a greater degree than heretofore the premium fair of Montana and Wyoming.

The building of a new section of the grandstand will be the chief feature of the construction and improvement program. It will be added to the south end of the present structure and will furnish more than 1,000 excellent seats just opposite the wild horse arena. The work will be done by contract and will start at once. The plans that will be used have been previously agreed upon by the board.
