

Large Wool Clip Is Sold at Good Price

A wool clip of 108,000 pounds was sold to S. Silberman & Sons of Chicago Saturday for 50 cents a pound by the G-B ranch, operated by O. K. Grimstad and Rockwood Brown, according to J. A. Hanlon, agent for the company at Billings.

The contract was made about the first of the year for the clip, which netted a choice grade of wool. "The high grade of wool from this clip is attributed to the exceptional care taken of the sheep as well as the abundance of feed, especially through the winter months," said Harry Mayer, a member of the Silberman firm.

The average of the clip was nearly 11 pounds per head and one band of 3,000 yearling ewes clipped nearly 12 pounds to the head.
