

Moon Creek Highway Will Be Extended

Miles City, May 25.—Prospects for the completion of a portion, about seven miles, of the Moon Creek highway, on the west side of Tongue river are excellent, following the trip made on Wednesday afternoon over the route by Rockwood Brown of Billings, member of the Montana highway commission, W. E. Dowlin, also of Billings, J. D. Scanlan and C. E. Shipman, the latter resident engineer of this city.

Leaving the city shortly after the close of the Commercial club luncheon at which the visitors spoke, the party went over the trail to Brandenburg, where they crossed the river and returned on the east side trail.

The work to be done on the Moon Creek highway is a part of the general plan to eventually complete a road south, to be known as a north and south road which will bring the communities a little closer to Miles City. It will cut off about 12 miles.
