

CENTER STRIPE TO BE PAINTED UPON ALL OILED ROADS

**ORDERS SO ISSUED BY
HIGHWAY ENGINEER
D. A. MCKINNON**

State Highway Engineer Don A. McKinnon yesterday issued orders to Maintenance Engineer E. B. Donohue to proceed as rapidly as possible with center-line striping on all the oiled roads in the state of Montana. It is expected that early delivery can be made on the necessary traffic-line paint and that all of this striping can be completed shortly after July 1.

This work is in line with the policy of the new highway commission recently appointed by Governor Cooney, of which Dr. H. J. McGregor of Great Falls is chairman and L. J. Croonenberghs of Missoula and Rockwood Brown of Billings are members, to give the maximum service to the travelling public. On his return from a recent trip to the west coast, Governor Cooney expressed his desire that this work be undertaken as soon as possible and Chief Engineer McKinnon is following in line with the governors' request.

There is probably no single service undertaken upon the highways that will prevent as many accidents as this one item. In their rules and regulations for the protection of the traveling public, the Montana highway patrol board, which is composed of the members of the highway commission, has ordered that the motorists must observe the center-line. The motorists of the state of Montana should be especially pleased with this order from Engineer McKinnon.
