

**ESTIMATE COST
TO BE \$60,000**

**Highway Commission
and B. P. R. Give
Approval.**

Survey of an eight-mile stretch of the feeder road west of Billings Municipal airport toward Shorey has been completed and the project will very likely be let this fall by the Montana highway commission, it was announced here Friday night by Rockwood Brown, local commission member.

The entire stretch is estimated to cost approximately \$60,000 and has been approved by the highway commission and bureau of public roads.

Starting in front of the airport, the highway will follow the edge of the scenic rimrocks for several miles and then turn north toward Shorey and Broadview, the commission member said.

With the letting scheduled early this fall, Mr. Brown explained that work on the project would very likely start immediately after the letting or by the first of next year.

Engineers from the local divisional office of the high commission were assigned to the survey.
