

**WOULD CHANGE
ROAD MARKINGS**

**Miles City Would Be
on Two Transconti-
nental Routes.**

Miles City will be on two trans-continental United States numbered highways, one terminating at Cooke City, and will be the terminus for a third United States highway, while Billings will also be placed on the Cooke City route, if the plans of Rockwood Brown, state highway commission member, work out, it was announced Wednesday night.

Brown has induced his fellow commission members to approve the plan, and a request has been made to the proper marking authorities at Washington, D. C. Miles City and Billings are already on U. S. highway No. 10. U. S. highway No. 12, originating at Chicago, through Baker, has Miles City for its terminus. The request asks that U. S. No. 12 be extended from Miles City through Billings to Laurel, coinciding with U. S. No. 310 and that, from that point over the scenic Red Lodge-Cooke City highway to the new northeastern en-
