

BROADVIEW-CITY FEEDER ROAD CONTRACT TO BE LET

CONTRACT for construction of at least four miles of the long-sought feeder road between Billings and Broadview will be let by the state highway commission May 8 at Helena.

Announcement of the action was made here Friday night by Rockwood Brown, local member of the state commission.

The portion which will be contracted at the May session of the group will extend from the point where the present Twenty-seventh street road to the airport terminates and will extend west along the rimrocks for at least four miles.

In addition to being a part of the state highway which will eventually extend over to Shorey, Broadview and Lavina, the portion of the road to be contracted will serve as an extension of the Rimrock drive being construct-

ed by works progress administration employes east of the airport to Boot-hill cemetery.

When the portion to be contracted is built, Billings residents may travel over the roof of the rimrocks for a distance of about two and a half miles east of the airport and four miles west of the port administration building, the commission member pointed out.

Joseph Rankin of Helena, right-of-way agent for the commission, arrived in Billings Friday for a conference with Mr. Brown Saturday morning.
