

STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS RESIGN POSTS

Holt-Appointed Body
Steps Out; Ayers to
Name New Commis-
sion on Thursday.

Helena, April 7.—(P)—Gov. Roy E. Ayers announced Wednesday afternoon the resignations of D. L. O'Hern of Miles City, and T. O. Collins of Deer Lodge, as members of the Montana highway commission, effective at once.

The third member, Fred Fligman, Great Falls, who had been board chairman, finished his term April 1.

"The resignations of Mr. O'Hern and Mr. Collins were voluntary on their part and I have accepted them," said a short statement given out by Governor Ayers.

The statement added that the resignations would necessitate appointment of an entire new commission and said Governor Ayers would appoint new board members "probably late Thursday afternoon."

The three board members were appointed by former Gov. Elmer Holt as successors to Dr. H. J. McGregor, Great Falls; Rockwood Brown, Billings, and L. J. Croonenberghs, Missoula, following their removal from office by the former governor for collection of alleged illegal fees.
