

LOCAL ATTORNEY SERIOUSLY HURT IN AUTO CRASH

Rockwood Brown Has
Knee Cap Fracture;
Cafe Man Suffers
Cuts and Bruises.

A collision between automobiles driven by Rockwood Brown, prominent Billings attorney, and L. G. Brannon, 107 North Thirty-third, early Saturday morning resulted in serious injury to Mr. Brown and severe cuts and bruises to Mr. Brannon and an employe. The accident occurred at First avenue and North Thirty-first street.

Mr. Brannon, who owns a local cafe, received a deep scalp wound and lacerations of the face, and Miss Ruby Straight, an employe, living at the Brannon residence, was bruised about the head and body. Both were taken to the Deaconess hospital.

Mr. Brown was removed to St. Vincent's hospital, where examination disclosed a transverse fracture of the knee cap. An operation was performed shortly before noon to suture the broken bone. Mrs. Brown, who was accompanying her husband to the railroad station, escaped without injury.

According to witnesses, the Brannon machine was moving east along First avenue, while Mr. Brown's car was traveling south along Thirty-first street. The cars met at the intersection.

Both machines were badly damaged by the impact. Witnesses said that Mr. Brannon was thrown through the window of his car, while Mr. Brown was injured when the cowl of his light coupe was shattered.
