

Judgment Entered In Damage Suits

On agreement of parties on both sides, the two damage suits against the G-B Sheep company filed in district court by Lewis G. Brannon and Ruby Straight as the result of an accident last November, judgments were entered against the defendant company for \$13,000 by Judge O. F. Goddard Friday.

Mr. Brannon was awarded \$7,250 for the injuries he sustained in the accident, and Ruby Straight was awarded \$5,750.

The accident occurred Nov. 8, 1930, when automobiles driven by Rockwood Brown and Mr. Brannon collided on First avenue north. In the complaints it is alleged that Mr. Brown, driving a car belonging to the G-B Sheep company, failed to stop before entering First avenue, a through street.

Mr. Brown was also injured in the accident. Brannon's injuries were considered the most serious, according to his attorneys. In the complaints \$27,500 damages were asked by Mr. Brannon and \$28,000 by Ruby Straight.
