is tightening up on all loans," Governor Ayers said. He said that in addition to the 10 state projects completed or under construction and one for which funds have recently been allocated, there remain six projects which have been approved by the state board and the PWA but for which no allocations have been made.

"Upon their arrival at Washington, Mr. Fabrick and Mr. James, with Mr. Warden, will contact officials of the PWA, the reclamation service, the works progress administration and all other government agencies necessary to secure allocations for the approved projects. It is the intention of the board to put into immediate execution every available agency in order that beginning of construction on the six projects may be expedited."

At present, Engineer James said, the 11 state water board projects financed by the PWA have received a total of \$4,024,270, of which \$1,656,270 was granted by the federal government. The six projects approved and awaiting allocations will cost approximately \$2,404,608.
