Mechanics of the state water board's operation were described by Rockwood Brown. He pointed out that the state board now has under contract proj- which will impound 200,000 acre-feet of water. Six other projects to cost \$3,000,000 and impound another 125,-000 acre-feet of water are pending the allocation of funds, he added.

"The main thing I'd like to impress upon the people of Montana," he said, "is that this water conservation program is not a program which can be completed in the next two or three years. It is a much more comprehensive program than that. We're planning for the future. Maybe it'll take 25 years, however long it takes, it will require the wholehearted cooperation of all the people of the state."

A parade of visiting delegations and bands early Saturday evening was followed by a water carnival, bathing beauty contest and street dancing.
