

## Storm Leaves Snow Blanket

## Lewistown Records -14 Temperature

April's two-day winter appeared virtually ended and spring advanced on Billings again Thursday as federal weather bureau officials at the bureau station at the municipal airport predicted "fair and warmer" for Friday.

Billings skies were cloudless Thursday and though temperatures remained unseasonably low the bright rays of the sun rapidly melted the snow in exposed places. Local residents had to cope with ice on the shady sides of the business district streets and to wade through slush on the sunny sides.

The heavy snow that had fallen late Wednesday brought the total precipitation for the first 10 days of April to 1.22 inches. Of that amount .32 of an inch was brought by the snowstorm. The above measurements were taken at the airport.
