

26 Participate In Plane Event

Best Model Flies 41 Seconds in Contest

Twenty-six youths participated Sunday in a rubber-propelled model airplane contest sponsored by the Billings Lions club on the hill northwest of the senior high school. Charles Hayden's entry in the senior high school division remained aloft the longest time, 41 seconds.

Although the club's glider contest was conducted April 6 under inclement weather conditions, several gliders were flown in connection with propelled models Sunday. Paul Nilson took gliding honors with his model, which remained in flight one minute, 15 seconds.

The contest for propelled machines was divided into grade school, junior high and senior high divisions. Winners were:

Grade school—James Carpenter, first; Robert Noe and Kenneth Sauvageau, tied for second, and Edward Heide, fourth.

Junior high—Bill Buckler, first, 23 seconds; Paul Nilson, second; Tom Heald and Jack Riedesel, tied for third; Richard Porter, fifth; Rockwood Brown, sixth.
