

## Trio Appointed To Fill Fair Board Vacancies

Brown, Hoiness and  
Maynard Succeed  
Retiring Directors

Three members of the board of directors of the Midland Empire fair have declined reappointment to the board at the expiration of their terms of office, and three Billings men have been selected for appointment as their successors, Yellowstone county commissioners announced Saturday night.

The retiring board members are J. W. Currie, president; Ben Cardwell, vice president, and J. W. Foote, each of whom has served several two-year terms on the board.

Those named to succeed them are Rockwood Brown, Billings attorney; C. M. Hoiness, local insurance man, and E. J. Maynard, Billings livestock specialist. Emmett Vaughn of Laurel and Ora F. Kemp of Shepherd are holdover members of the board.

The retiring directors will continue to serve until expiration of their terms on December 8, but their successors have been invited to attend the October meeting of the board and all subsequent regular and special meetings. Currie notified the county commissioners.

Currie also announced that the new members will be asked to take part in selection of a new manager for the fair, to succeed Harry L. Pfitzer, who resigned Tuesday to accept a similar position with the North Montana fair at Great Falls. Several applications have been received for the position at Billings, it was announced.

The new members all have been appointed for two-year terms. Official appointments will be made in December.

Brown, who resides at 1119 North Thirty-first street, is a former member of the state highway commission and the state water conservation board.

Hoiness, who resides at 338 Grand avenue, has been engaged in the insurance business here for about 15 years. He was formerly a member of the board of directors of the Billings Commercial club.

Maynard, local livestock and feeding specialist, was dean of agriculture and forestry at Utah State Agricultural college before coming to Billings. He resides at 108 Spruce street.
