

## Another Polio Case Reported in County

removed Monday night from the isolation ward at St. Vincent hospital to the orthopedic department for convalescent treatment, Sister Ascella said. The transfer leaves 22 in the isolation ward.

Investigation of the polio epidemic was well under way Tuesday, according to city officials and Lieutenant Colonel A. G. Gillian, senior surgeon of the bureau of state services. Gillian, who arrived here Sunday is visiting homes of polio patients to secure information as to case histories and circumstances surrounding illnesses.

In addition to the 46 Yellowstone county polio cases, there have been seven in surrounding areas and one from Sheridan, Wyo., brought here for treatment. The last polio death, that of a Billings child, occurred October 7. There have been four deaths among city residents, three among residents in county areas outside the city and one among those brought here from other areas.
