

Mustang Directors to Name Officers Today; Annual Club Report Given

Billings Pioneer Baseball club directors will meet at noon Wednesday in the Northern hotel to elect officers for the 1951 season, Russ B. Hart, retiring Mustang president, said Tuesday.

In addition to the annual election, trustees will also reorganize their own group and discuss plans for the coming year.

The annual stockholders meeting was conducted Monday night, it was reported Tuesday, with four directors being renamed for three-year terms. The four, who have constituted the Mustangs' executive committee since the inception of

the club, include Hart, Rockwood Brown, Archie Cochrane and Robert E. Cooke.
