


**Rockwood Brown . . .
Prominent

Lawyer Dies**

BILLINGS (AP)—Rockwood Brown, prominent local attorney and one-time chairman of the State Highway Commission, died Monday of a heart attack while vacationing in Florida, his family here was notified. Mrs. Brown was with him at the time of his death in Maples, Fla. Brown, 69, a native of Vermont, moved here 40 years ago and entered law practice. He was a senior member of the firm of Brown, Sande and Forbes here. He also served as chairman of the State Water Conservation Board and when he died he was a member of the City Park Commission. Survivors, besides his widow, include three sons and a daughter.
