

Rockwood Brown Stricken, Dies

BILLINGS (U.P.) — Rockwood Brown, prominent local attorney and onetime chairman of the State Highway Commission, died Monday of a heart attack while vacationing in Florida, his family here was notified.

Mrs. Brown was with him at the time of his death Monday morning in Maples, Fla.

Brown, 69, a native of Vermont, moved here 40 years ago and entered law practice. He was a senior member of the firm of Brown, Sande and Forbes here at the time of his death.

He also served as chairman of the State Water Conservation Board and when he died he was a member of the City Park Commission. Survivors, besides his widow, include three sons and a daughter.
