

Bentonite. Wyoming continues to lead the nation with the production of bentonite exceeding over one million tons annually. The bulk of the production comes from Big Horn, Crook, Natrona, and Weston counties. During the year, Wyo-Ben Products made extensive additions and improvements to their mill near Greybull, and the Archer-Daniels-Midland Co. completed a new mill near Colony. The latter company supplied pulverized bentonite to the taconite industry of Minnesota; however, the operations were curtailed in October because of a fire.
