

## Mine Safety Awards Are Presented

JACKSON, Wyo. (UPI)—U.S. Steel's Atlantic City iron ore operation won the Wyoming State Board of Mines' top safety award for 1965 at the State Mining Association meeting Friday.

The mine was cited for 917,609 man hours without lost time for an accident during 1963. The mine employed 480 men, the citation said.

Second place went to the nuclear division of Union Carbide uranium operations in Gas Hills for 131,040 man hours without an accident with 35 men employed.

Third went to Wyo-Ben Products Company's bentonite operation at Greybull for 68,960 man hours and 28 men employed. Fourth went to the Benton Clay Co. for 22,134 man hours from 10 employees.
