

## Wyo-Ben Names Paustian to Directorship

GREYBULL — Chris J. Paustian, superintendent of the Greybull Wyo-Ben Products bentonite plant, has been elected to the board of directors of the company, it was announced this week.

He has also been promoted to vice president in charge of mining and production for the company.

Paustian has been in the bentonite business since 1944 and has been in Greybull since the plant was built 18 years ago.

The Greybull plant has grown from a small operation with five men on the payroll to the present modern plant that employs 44 men. Production has grown from 7,500 tons to 200,000 tons per year in the eighteen years.
