

LEGION ATHLETIC CLUB FORMED; BOARD NAMED

Articles were filed Monday in the office of the county recorder, incorporating the American Legion Athletic association, which, according to the temporary president, O. King Grimstad, has been formed not only to take advantage of the privileges granted under the state boxing law, but to promote sports of all kinds. Its membership, Mr. Grimstad said, will not be restricted to war veterans, the purpose being to invite citizens generally to join.

The county athletic commission, provided for by the boxing law, was appointed yesterday afternoon by Judge Spencer, of the district court. The members are Dr. T. V. Moore, Walter Innes and Joe Markham.

Mr. Grimstad is temporary president of the association, and D. Arnold Hays, secretary. Both will serve until the election of permanent officers next month.

A luncheon will be given by the Commercial club next week, it is stated, to discuss plans which it is hoped will work out ultimately in the erection of a substantial and adequate clubhouse as the home of the new association.

The association's first entertainment is being arranged for a date in January. The committee in charge of this affair includes Dr. Moore, T. C. Thompson and T. E. Bohan.

"The association has not been organized solely for the promotion of boxing bouts," said Mr. Grimstad. "Sports of all kinds will engage its attention, and its aim will be to interest all classes of men in healthful recreation."
