The three acres at the extreme southeastern corner of the Midland Empire fairgrounds which Yellowstone county traded to the state last week for land to the north of the exposition grounds is to become the site of a park, it was said Monday by Rockwood Brown, state highway commissioner who negotiated the transaction on behalf of his organization.

Primarily the purpose of the exchange, from the standpoint of the state, was to obtain a right of way making it possible to reduce the curves from the northern approach of the new east bridge across the Yellowstone river to the culvert midway between the bridge and the main entrance to the fairgrounds. A beautification program along the stretch, similar to that completed a few months ago along the western portion of Montana avenue, will supplement the park undertaking, according to Mr. Brown.
