Billings was elected vice chairman, and A. T. Peterson, superintendent of schools here, was elected secretary.

The council, meeting after the general dinner session, provided that Dr. Sayre should draft a constitution, rules of membership and to prepare for the annual meeting. The council voted that the membership shall include anyone interested in the society and its objectives and that the dues shall be \$1 annually. Dr. H. T. Gisborn of the United States forestry department, Missoula, was named liaison officer to secure the cooperation of the Northwest Scientific society with the newly-formed Montana society.
