

CARTER OIL PLANS WILDCAT SOUTHWEST OF VERNAL

Carter Oil Co. Tuesday announced it would drill a wildcat deep test nine and one-half miles southwest of Vernal.

The well, to be known as No. 1 Rockwood Brown, is in section five, township five south and range 20 east.

It will be drilled to a depth of 9000 feet in the basal Greenriver formation, from whence comes production at the Carter-Stanolind Oil and Gas Co.'s wells at Roosevelt pool, 10 miles to the northeast.

The Rockwood Brown wildcat is on Carter's 52,000-acre Vernal unit, scene two years ago of the Ruth Nelson No. 1 wildcat, which had good oil shows but failed to become a producer.
