

Brown Re-Elected By Park Board

The Park Board has re-elected Rockwood Brown Jr., as its president and on a motion by Mayor Howard Hultgren elected Vern Drake as vice president.

The next Park Board meeting will be a special session to consider a proposal from Drake to create a Historical Sites and Buildings Advisory Committee.

THE SPECIAL session is tentatively set May 21 at the airport.

Purpose of the proposed committee would be to inventory historical buildings and sites to take action to preserve them, Mayor Hultgren said Monday.

Among proposed sites to be inventoried are the Indian Caves, Sacrifice Cliff, buildings moved to Billings from Coulson; Parmly Billings Memorial Library, the Moss mansion, the

“Castle”, and other buildings and sites from prehistoric to modern days.

THE PARK Board approved an use agreement on Cobb Field for the Legion baseball club. The agreement was between the Pioneer Baseball Club and the Park Dept.

The Board considered applying for membership in the National Recreation and Park Association.
