

Will Survey Oiled Road Near Greybull

GREYBULL — The preliminary survey of an oiled road to the Wyo Ben plant, north of Greybull will be started in the near future and will bring the much needed road nearer a reality, it was reported after a meeting of the Big Horn County Commissioners.

The Commissioners entered into an agreement with the Wyoming Highway Department to do the survey.

After the survey the Wyo Ben will use its equipment to bring the road up to secondary specifications and the county road equipment will be used when available also.

It is hoped that the company and county can get the road bed in condition for a seal coat and oiling job.

No commitment on the oiling was made since both State and County funds will be used to finance the final road contract.

The present road has been oiled to the Dresser plant, and the survey will go on for the six miles to Wyo Ben.

Traffic has increased steadily over this piece of road, and commissioners agreed that it should have a high priority.
