

Bentonite Plants To Cut Down Dust

GREYBULL, Wyo. (UPI) — Two bentonite plants near Greybull are installing new air pollution devices in further efforts to cut down the amount of escaping dust from their smokestacks.

Dresser Minerals has already spent \$100,000 on dust control at the facility and plans to add a \$150,000 electrostatic dust control system. Lee Grenier, resident plant manager, said it will take about four months to install the new equipment once it arrives.

Wyo-Ben Products Inc. will soon be installing a \$20,000 filtering system to cut down its dust emissions. The plant already has reduced its dust emission level to less than state requirements.

Engineers say the only stack emissions from either plant will consist of nothing but steam once the planned equipment is added.
