

Happy With 4 Days

Employees and employers are satisfied with the new four-day work week at the Wyo-Ben Bentonite plant in Greybull, according to Gary Bernard, plant superintendent.

Bernard said that as far as he knows, this is the first such operation in Wyoming.

The Greybull plant went over to the four 10-hour day week on June 1, which enables employees

to work the same number of hours per week, and gives them a three-day weekend.

Mill operators, mechanics, and truck drivers as well as office personnel are working under the new plan.

Bernard said the four-day week is still being conducted on a experimental basis for the plant's 60 employees.
