

INFANTILE PARALYSIS KILLS 82 IN NEW YORK

NEW YORK, July 3.—The epidemic of infantile paralysis here has climbed tonight to 82 lives. Since Saturday noon there have been 23 deaths. Many new cases are reported.

The department of health is waging a campaign to prevent the spread of the epidemic and today placed placards warning the public to keep away from streets where there are one or more cases. More than 500,000 pamphlets containing warnings and describing preventatives, were sent broadcast over the city and suburbs.
