Q. What is bentonite? R. P.

A. Bentonite is a bedded plastic clay which swells greatly upon wetting. It is used as sizing for paper, absorbent in dynamite manufacture, retarder for hard (gypsum) plaster, adulterant in candles and drugs, hoof packing, and as a constituent of a remedial dressing.
