

## NEEDED MONTANA TO GET WARMTH

E. W. Keene, Owner of 4-K  
Ranch, Home From Visit  
to Coast Cities.

Like the governor of Alaska who was quoted a few days ago in Omaha as saying that he wished he was home so that he could get warm, E. W. Keene, prominent Billings citizen, arrived in Butte yesterday from California to find himself "in a decent climate" for the first time since he left the Sugarbeet metropolis.

Mr. Keene, who is said to own the only private nine-hole golf course in the state which is located at his famous "4-K" ranch near Billings, spent the last several weeks in California points. Mrs. Keene and children went south with him but will spend several more weeks before returning to Montana.

The Billings man is owner of the Keene Motor Car company which distributes Packard and Oldsmobile cars in Montana. During his visit he attended a Packard convention in Los Angeles.

"I never felt warm while I was around Sacramento or San Diego," the Billings man remarked. "When the train came into Montana I warmed right up even though the ground was covered with snow. The damp atmosphere down there is anything but comfortable."

Mr. Keene yesterday visited with local agents. He will leave for Billings today.
