

## KEENE TOURNEY LURES GOLFERS

### More Than 50 Will Play Mountain Links Today.

More than 50 golfers will participate in the annual golf tourney at E. W. Keene's 4-K ranch in the Bear-tooth mountains. The tournament will be staged in connection with the formal public opening of the beautiful resort, located 17 miles southwest of Fishtail.

The only event on the local golfing calendar for the day will be the continuation of qualifying rounds for the Hitop Public course championship.

Both country clubs are sending large groups while smaller parties from the public courses are planning to attend. Most of the mashie wielders will leave early Sunday, although a few went to the ranch Saturday night.

The "spread" is open to the public and reservations may be made at any time for the balance of the season, Mr. Keene announced while here Wednesday.

Bill Roberts, Highlands club pro, will be in charge of the tournament. He laid out the course several years ago and has directed improvements from time to time.

The course is considered one of the sportiest in the state, as well as one of the most beautiful. It has clover and grass fairways, a variety of tricky greens and is high enough to be cool on the hottest day, according to the pro.

The ranch is regarded as one of the outstanding dude spreads in the mountain region. The last unit, the central lodge, was completed a few weeks ago. Mr. Keene spent several years in developing the property and plans to operate it primarily for Montana residents.
