The 4K ranch, located in the Bear-tooth mountains 72 miles southwest of Billings, has been sold to Julius Peters of Great Falls and his eastern associates, it was announced Saturday by E. W. Keene, former owner.

Keene arrived in Billings Saturday morning after spending a week at the ranch, to meet the new owners. While at the ranch he was engaged in getting out logs for the construction of new cabins, and in taking an inventory of cattle and horses which were turned over to a caretaker for Peters.

Peters is a prominent oil operator and owns the Badger Basin field of the Resolute Oil company, located north of Cody on the Clark's Fork river, Keene said.

Located near Dean, the lodge and cabins stand on the edge of a hog-back, overlooking a heavily forested area containing numerous lakes, creeks and scenic trails.

The lodge at the 4K ranch is 32 by 60 feet and has two large fireplaces, one at either end of the main room. In the center of the room stands a circular fountain, made of native stones, while rustic furniture made at the ranch fills the room.

Just back of the lodge is a 300-foot waterfall and above that is a 10-acre lake, 90 feet deep. Directly in front of the lodge is a large swimming pool. A nine-hole golf course lies near the ranch and 23 riding trails are near by.

The new owners plan to develop the ranch for purely private recreational uses, it was announced.
