

Accountant Dies Of Heart Ailment

John Clinton Alguire, 49, an accountant who lived at 723 Park Lane, died at a Billings hospital at 11:45 a.m. Thursday of a heart ailment after an illness of eight months, the last four of which was spent in the hospital.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. Luke's Episcopal Church. Burial will be in Mountview Cemetery.

Mr. Alguire was born at Ellis, S.D., five miles west of Sioux Falls, July 16, 1903, the son of Mr. and Mrs. John L. Alguire. The family moved to Beach, N.D., in 1910 and he resided there until coming to Billings six years ago.

He was married to Edna Margaret Woods at Glendive in 1928. Mr. Alguire was a member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Prior Mountain Lodge, A.F. & A.M., the Scottish Rite and Al Bedoo Temple of the Shrine.

He leaves the wife, a son, John William, 12; a daughter, Mrs. Rockwood Brown Jr., of Spokane, whose husband is a first lieutenant in the air force and stationed there; his mother, Mrs. Marie E. Alguire of Beach; a brother, Guerdon M., Beach; a sister, Mrs. C. N. Middleton, Denver, and one grandchild.
