Most seriously injured was Barbara Tiddens, 9, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Adolf Tiddens of 1702 Ave. F, who suffered an extensive burn on her left forearm when the Roman candle she was holding exploded.

Connie Henley, 7, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Earl Henley of 1620 Wyoming Ave., received burns and a laceration of the thumb when a firecracker went off in her hand.

Scott Brown, 6, son of Mr. and Mrs. Rockwood Brown of 1013 Ave. F, and Duane House, 12, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ellis House of Rt. 2, both sustained finger burns in similar firecracker accidents.
