

## NEW HIGHWAY BUILDING TO BE PLACED UNDER CONTRACT HERE AT HIGHWAY LETTING, JUNE 16

Contract will be let on Montana's new highway commission building. Tuesday, June 16, it was announced yesterday by D. A. McKinnon, state highway engineer.

At this time also there will be the regular June letting of highway contracts, consisting of several jobs rejected by the commission in the past because bids were too high.

The new highway commission building will cost approximately \$145,000 and will be located on the corner of Sixth avenue and Roberts street, across the street in front of the capitol.

The building will be two stories

and will be reinforced concrete and built along earthquake resistive lines. It will be finished with Dunite to correspond with the granite rock finish of the main capital buildings.

The contractor who gets the job will be required to complete the project by December 15, in order that the senate chambers and the committee rooms, now being utilized, may be vacated by the legislative session.

The state board of examiners yesterday approved of the plans, specifications and location of the new building.
